NCC to construct Jetsmark School Center

Jetsmark School Center will be built as a three-form entry school for reception class to year 9 with integrated breakfast and after school club and space for preschoolers. The school is due to be completed in August 2023.

NCC has been awarded the main contract to build Jetsmark School Center. This will give the three towns of Moseby, Kaas and Pandrup in Jammerbugt Municipality a new school that will also serve as a cultural center for the area's other residents.

"I'm really glad we won the contract to build Jetsmark school Center for Jammerbugt Municipality. It's going to be an impressive and exciting school. We're very much looking forward to getting started on another school construction project for Jammerbugt Municipality," said Jakob Søe Lundgaard, NCC's project manager for the build.

"Based on the five tenders we received for the project, the steering committee and municipal council of Jammerbugt Municipality have chosen NCC Denmark as the main contractor for the new school in Jetsmark. Following our evaluation process, we have determined that they are the best people to carry out the project. Their tender was also the lowest one submitted. We look forward to working together on this project," said Mogens Christen Gade, who is the mayor and chair of the steering committee.

One of the things Jammerbugt Municipality placed importance on when choosing the main contractor was the fact that NCC has competent and experienced key personnel, who all bring experience from roles in projects of relevance to the tendered work in terms of their content, size, scope and complexity.

"I'm pleased that the municipality has noticed all the skills we have in this area and given us the highest rating in its evaluation of our tender. It's always great when there is faith in us as a contractor right from the start," said Region Director Bjørn Christensen from NCC in North Jutland.

A learning and cultural center for the Jetsmark area

The school will be a learning and cultural center for the towns of Pandrup, Kaas and Moseby in Jetsmark, and will become a landmark for the area.

The new school center will be an architecturally significant building that creates an identity, supporting the children's learning, wellbeing and cultural education. The construction style will also ensure that the school is an attractive place to work and opens the doors for the local community to be actively involved in the everyday life of the school.

"We're now on the verge of beginning construction of the new school in Jetsmark. The aspirations that we and the users of the school had for the construction project are being fulfilled, in terms of functionality, architecture and the pedagogical visions behind the project. Throughout the construction process, we will continue to focus on ongoing dialogue with local residents and stakeholders. When the school is finished in spring 2023, people in the area can look forward to an exciting school that will support cohesion in the Jetsmark area," declared mayor Mogens Christen Gade.

The school will provide an optimal framework for the various activities and events that are part of the teaching provided there. In addition, the local cultural and sports scene will also benefit from the new school's facilities. This is why Jammerbugt Municipality is building a flexible and multi-use school, where both outdoor and indoor spaces can be used for as many purposes as possible.

Jetsmark School Centre will be built as a three-form entry school for reception class to year 9 with integrated breakfast and after school club and space for preschoolers from 1 April to 1 August. Sports and exercise activities take place at the nearby Jetsmark Sports Center. A maximum of 200 children are expected to attend the breakfast and after school club each year. The gross floor area of the school will be approximately 8,500 square meters.

Building work will start at the end of March 2021 and is expected to be completed for occupation in August 2023. The total budget is DKK 152 million. NCC's share is DKK 117 million.

NCC previously built Aabybro School for Jammerbugt Municipality.
